## An International M.A./LL.M. Degree Program in Conflict Resolution: International Law and Conflict Resolution

Registration for the 2017-18 academic year has opened.

### A joint interdisciplinary program of the Swiss Center at the Faculty of Social Sciences and of the Faculty of Law.

Study at the Hebrew University in Jerusalem and gain insights into the local and global conflicts and disputes. This program focuses on the sources and causes of domestic and external conflicts in general and in Israel in particular.

You will explore the methods, techniques, and strategies that help manage and resolve these conflicts from different disciplinary points of view, including international relations, law, political science, social psychology, communication and media studies, and sociology.

The prestigious Faculty of Law and the Faculty of Social Sciences at the Hebrew University are offering an exclusive graduate degree program (M.A./LL.M.) focusing on conflict resolution and international law, which is taught in English in Jerusalem over the course of two semesters.

Students will be taught by past and present legal advisors to international organizations, members of international expert bodies, government and NGO lawyers and leading academics from Israel and abroad.

**Duration:** 1 academic year (two semesters).

**Course Load:** 32 credits.

#### Admission Requirements:

Minimum B.A. average required - 85 (Israeli students) or the equivalent (non-Israeli students), and a high level of fluency in English speaking, reading and writing.

**Degree:** M.A./LL.M., in International Law and Conflict Resolution.

- Students with a LL.B. in Law will be able to receive either an M.A. or a LL.M. in International Law and Conflict Resolution.
- Other students will receive an M.A. in International Law and Conflict Resolution.

**Tuition:** \$16,000
